



**Job Title: Activity Specialist- Aquatics**

**Classification:** Temporary- up to 5 weeks (June 8-July 14, 2018)- Salaried

**Position Purpose:**

This position will oversee the activities, programs, and Learning Centers associated with the swimming areas. The individual will act as head lifeguard. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

**Essential Job Functions:**

- Administer swim tests to campers
- Clearly communicate and enforce rules during pool and waterfront activities.
- Supervise and train other lifeguards in maintaining a safe environment in the swimming areas.
- Monitor the condition of the pool area and water cleanliness.
- Lead and plan Learning Centers in the swimming areas.
- Assist program with water activities including lifeguard coverage.

**Other Job Duties:**

- Counselor: you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties at the pool.
- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

**Relationships:**

You will be able to work with other Activity Specialists to coordinate the use of areas or work together to accomplish your goals. Communicating with the Head Counselors is encouraged for the purpose of enhancing the program. Coordinating with the Program Coordinator and Staff Coordinator will be critical.

**Equipment Used:**

Lifeguarding equipment, water sport items, and pool maintenance equipment.

**Qualifications:**

Candidate must have current lifeguard certification from a recognized provider, and at least two years of lifeguard experience (camp is willing to facilitate certification).

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.

Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.

Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

**Physical Aspects of the Job:**

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
