



Job Title: Activity Specialist- Nature/Lifeguard

Classification: Temporary- up to 5 weeks (June 8-July 14, 2018)- Salaried

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee the Nature Learning Center for age groups ranging from 7-16. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Outline lesson plans to teach nature oriented classes that meet Camp Conquest ministry and safety guidelines as well as ACA standards.
- Set up and maintain the Nature Hut/Classroom.
- Maintain the necessary tools and equipment to perform the activities.
- Initiate strict safety program including security and safety of all animals and equipment.
- Lifeguard the pond when in use by campers involved in the nature program.

Other Job Duties:

- Counselor: you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties.
- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

Relationships:

You will be able to work with other Activity Specialists to coordinate the use of areas or work together to accomplish your goals. Communicating with the Head Counselors is encouraged for the purpose of enhancing the program. Coordinating with the Program Coordinator and Staff Coordinator will be critical.

Equipment Used:

Tanks, nets, fishing rods, buckets, microscopes, classroom materials, and Corcl's as well as stream, pond, and 90 acres of wooded area and trails.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.

Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.

Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Basic knowledge of the natural world, demonstrating a desire to preserve and protect the environment and God's creation.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
