



Job Title: Craft Volunteer

Classification: Temporary- up to 5 weeks (June 8-July 14, 2018)

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee the craft cabin and related activities for age groups ranging from 7-16. Fulfillment of this position is flexible depending on the applicant's availability. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Organize craft materials for each group of campers coming to the craft cabin.
- Give out instructions to campers for completing crafts.
- Aid campers in completing crafts.
- Clean and organize the craft cabin.
- Maintain a safe working environment.
- Maintain and organize all craft materials and equipment.

Other Job Duties:

- Counselor: If available for a week, you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties at the range.

Relationships:

The Craft Coordinator will train you on the crafts being completed each week and craft cabin organization in order to help you accomplish your goals. Communicating with the Head Counselors and Program Coordinator is encouraged for the purpose of enhancing the program.

Equipment Used:

Necessary craft materials, tools, and other craft equipment.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
