



Job Title: Head Male Counselor- Day Camp

Classification: Temporary- up to 5 weeks (June 8-July 14, 2018)- Salaried

Position Purpose:

This position will be the Head Male Counselor for the activities and schedule associated with Day Camp. Day Camp is Monday-Friday, 8am-4pm. In this role, you will be guiding the counselors and campers, under the direction of the Day Camp Coordinator, through the daily schedule. This is a leadership role that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry and mission.

Essential Job Functions:

- Manage and direct a schedule that creates a week long progression of intentional ministry within community.
- Train and equip volunteer staff.
- Handle all male counselor and camper conflicts and issues.
- Invest in and support campers, counselors, and the program.
- Lead under 18 staff in the evenings, following their evening and weekend schedules.
- Manage and care for all Day Camp materials, equipment, and program areas.

Other Job Duties:

- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs.

Relationships:

You will be able to work with adult volunteers from local churches and Junior Staff volunteers. Communicating with the Resident Camp Head Counselors is encouraged for the purpose of enhancing the program. Communicating and working with the Day Camp Coordinator will be critical.

Equipment Used:

All equipment related to the Day Camp program and normal camp activities, golf carts

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
