



Job Title: Day Camp Counselor/Lifeguard

Classification: Temporary- up to 6 weeks (June 7-July 20, 2019) - Salaried

Position Purpose:

This position will act as a counselor for the Day Camp program and the lifeguard for Day Camp when campers are at the pool and other water activities. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Partner with volunteers and Junior Staff to lead a group of campers through the Day Camp schedule each day.
- Act as the lifeguard while Day Camp campers are at the pool.
- Clearly communicate and enforce rules during pool and waterfront activities.
- Monitor the condition of the pool area and water cleanliness.
- Administer swim tests to campers

Other Job Duties:

- Program: following the closing of Day Camp each day, counselors will assist in the running of activities for Overnight Camp programming.
- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

Relationships:

You will be able to work with other Day Camp counselors and volunteers to accomplish the goals of Day Camp. The Day Camp Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with him/her will be critical. The Challenge Activities/Aquatics Instructor will oversee all water areas and activities, and communication with him/her will be important.

Equipment Used:

Lifeguarding equipment, water sport items, and pool maintenance equipment.

Qualifications:

Candidate must have current lifeguard certification from a recognized provider (camp is willing to facilitate certification). Lifeguarding experience is preferred.

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.

Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.

Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate will participate in lifeguard training and exercise. Candidates should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
