



Job Title: Day Camp Counselor/Worship Leader

Classification: Temporary- up to 6 weeks (June 7-July 20, 2018) - Salaried

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee any worship functions for Day Camp during summer camp programming. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Partner with volunteers and Junior Staff to lead a group of campers through the Day Camp schedule each day.
- Responsible for organizing, performing, and leading music for Day Camp.
- Plan and lead chapel worship, utilizing the musical gifts of others at camp.
- Organize chord sheets and power point slide shows for chapel worship.
- Lead music for activities such as the daily closing and end of week church program.
- Organize all music equipment and ensure all equipment is working properly.
- Work with the Worship, Media & Tech Leader and Day Camp Coordinator to enhance the worship ministry for Day Camp staff and campers.

Other Job Duties:

- Program: following the closing of Day Camp each day, counselors will assist in the running of activities for Overnight Camp programming.
- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

Relationships:

You will be able to work with other Day Camp Counselors and volunteers to accomplish the goals of Day Camp. Communication and coordination with the Worship, Media & Tech Leader will be critical. The Day Camp Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with him/her will be important.

Equipment Used:

Instruments, sound boards, speakers, mics, stands, power point, and other sound/music equipment.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.
Ability to play instruments, especially guitar.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
