

Job Title: Horse Volunteer

Classification: Temporary- up to 5 weeks (June 17-July 19, 2019)

Position Purpose:

This position will assist with the activities, programs, and Learning Centers of the horse program. Fulfillment of this position is flexible depending on the applicant's availability. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Assist in leading campers in ground and riding lessons.
- Assist in the care of horses including feeding, grooming, and cleaning the horses.
- Assist in maintaining, cleaning, and organizing riding equipment, riding ring, barn, and fields.
- Be available to the Barn Manager and Horse Instructor to help with horse program needs.

Other Job Duties:

- Counselor: If available for a week, you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties at the range.

Relationships:

You will be to work with the Barn Manager and Horse Instructor to accomplish your goals. Communication and coordination with these two will be critical.

Equipment Used:

Horses, riding equipment, groom and cleaning equipment.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.

Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.

Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
