



Job Title: Media and Tech

Classification: Weekly (June 17-July 20, 2018) - Volunteer

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee the audio/video operations of all summer camp programming. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Assist in the set up and operation of sound and video equipment during chapels, assemblies, and campfires in multiple locations and environments.
- Assist worship leader in planning and set up for chapel and campfire.
- Assist speakers with any audio/video needs.
- Organize pictures and videos into slide shows to be shown in chapel and at the closing program.
- Ensure audio/video equipment is set up, working properly, and put away in proper place.
- Organize sound equipment and sound closet throughout the summer.

Other Job Duties:

- Counselor: you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties.
- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

Relationships:

You will be able to work with the Worship, Media & Tech Leader to coordinate the use of areas or work together to accomplish your goals. Communication and coordination with the Worship, Media & Tech Leader and Photographers will be critical. The Support Staff Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with him/her and the Overnight Camp and Day Camp Coordinators will be important.

Equipment Used:

Cameras, video equipment, laptops, sound boards, speakers, and other sound equipment.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.
Knowledge of audio/video equipment and editing software.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
