

Job Title: Rifle Volunteer

Classification: Weekly (June 17-July 19, 2019)

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee the activities, programs, and Learning Centers of the rifle range. Fulfillment of this position is flexible depending on the applicant's availability. This is a mission experience that contributes to the fulfillment of the objectives of the program ministry.

Essential Job Functions:

- Teach Learning Centers that meet Camp Conquest ministry and safety guidelines as well as ACA standards.
- Communicate and demonstrate skills as well as helping campers learn skills.
- Control range when in use.
- Establish security of all equipment when not in use.
- Maintain the range area and keep all equipment in good, safe working order.
- Inventory all equipment at beginning and end of summer.
- Engage in additional target sports such as BB guns, rock throwing, tomahawks, and slingshots.

Other Job Duties:

- Counselor: If available for a week, you will be a part of an assigned cabin group and will assist the other counselors when you are not engaged in your duties at the range.

Relationships:

You will be able to work with the Target Sports Instructor to coordinate the use of areas or work together to accomplish your goals. The Support Staff Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with him/her and the Overnight Camp Coordinator will be important.

Equipment Used:

Necessary targets, safety equipment, and firearms.

Qualifications:

Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.

Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.

Candidate should have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Experience with target sports preferred and completion of NRA Basic Rifle Training Course in June.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. Camp itself involves a lot of walking and requires good management of down time.
