



Job Title: Craft Cabin Coordinator

Classification: up to year-round - Volunteer

Position Purpose:

- This position oversees the craft cabin (supplies, set up, summer craft creations and other craft creations for parent child weekends).
- This is a mission experience that engages your gifting, to serve others, so the body of Christ can be built up.

Essential Job Functions:

- Oversee & Organize Craft Cabin.
- Gather donated and purchased useful craft supplies.
- Create Summer Camp Craft. Have sample, instructions & supplies for
 - o Pioneer Camp (ages 7-9)
 - o Adventure Camp (ages 10-12)
 - o Quest Camp (ages 13-15)
 - o REAL and TRUE (ages 13-15)
- Create other simple crafts ideas for Cabin choice.
- Train Weekly Craft Cabin Volunteers (3 weeks of volunteers in summer)
- Maintain Craft Cabin supplies (weekly in summer)
- Create Parent Child Craft and lead or train craft volunteer.

Other Job Duties:

- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in the camp programs.
- Can attend Program Committee meeting in which yearly theme is approved.

Relationships:

- Communicating with the Craft Cabin Volunteers will be crucial. Reports to Program Coordinator.

Qualifications:

- Candidate should be minimum 18 years old and be out of High School one year.
- Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
- Candidate must have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment.
