



Job Title: Counselor

Classification: Temporary- 8 weeks (June 15 – August 7, 2026) - Salaried

Position Purpose:

- This position will oversee campers in Overnight and Day camp programming.
- This is a mission experience that engages your gifting, to serve others, so the body of Christ can be built up.

Essential Job Functions:

- Lead campers through daily schedules and programming.
- Lead small group and campfire debrief times.
- Oversee the care of campers during all aspects of the day (wake up, bedtime, activities, meals, etc.).
- Lead and participate in camp activities such as games, songs, skits, and all camp gatherings.

Other Job Duties:

- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs.

Relationships:

- We strive to have a 4:1 Camper-to-Counselor ratio, per group.
- You will be able to work with volunteers, Sr. Staff, Jr. Staff, and STACC participants as well as other counselors to accomplish the goals of summer camp.
- You will be under the direct leadership of the Team Leader for the age you are counseling.
- The Program Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with them will be important.

Equipment Used:

- Sports equipment, game supplies, activity equipment, theme materials.

Qualifications:

- Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
- Candidate must have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment.
- Camp itself involves a lot of walking up and down hills.
- Requires good management of down time.
