



Job Title: Dining Hall & Dish Room Lead

Classification: Temporary- 9 weeks (June 8 – August 7, 2026). Salaried.

Position Purpose:

- This position oversees the safe and efficient operation of the dining hall and dish room during core programs.
- This is a mission experience that engages your gifting, to serve others, so the body of Christ can be built up.

Essential Job Functions:

- Oversee and manage the dining hall including set up, turnover, and clean-up of the dining hall.
- Instruct campers and staff of the rules and procedures of the dining hall.
- Coordinate with the Head Cook the distribution of food at appropriate times.
- Oversee the dish pit and the clean-up of dishes, kitchen equipment, and tables.
- Close the dining hall at the end of the day.
- Manage paper and janitorial supplies in dining hall.
- Monitor refrigerator and freezer temperatures daily.
- Wash kitchen towels and aprons.

Other Job Duties:

- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available, helpful, and active at camp programs as you are able.

Relationships:

- Reports to the Foodservice Coordinator. Communicating with the Foodservice Coordinator and Weekly Head Cook will be critical. You will have the opportunity to work with volunteers, STACC, and Jr Staff.

Equipment Used:

- Most food service related equipment.

Qualifications:

- Candidate should be minimum 18 years old and be out of High School one year.
- Candidate must have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Candidate should be comfortable using a variety of food service equipment and be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment. The kitchen operates three meals a day and a snack and requires good management of down time.
