



Job Title: Worship Leader

Classification: Temporary- 8 weeks (June 15 – August 7, 2026) - Salaried

Position Purpose:

This position will oversee any worship functions during summer camp programming. This is a mission experience that engages your gifting, to serve others, so the body of Christ can be built up.

Essential Job Functions:

- Set up chapel and campfire areas.
- Plan and lead chapel and campfire worship, utilizing the musical gifts of others at camp.
- Lead music for activities such as assembly and the closing program.
- Organize all music equipment and sound closet, and ensure all equipment is working properly throughout the summer.

Other Job Duties:

- As a member of the staff, you will assist with weekly preparation of the camp for the next group of volunteers and campers.
- Be available and willing to run/participate in other camp programs

Relationships:

- The Program Coordinator will oversee this role and communication with them will be important.

Equipment Used:

- Instruments, sound boards, speakers, mics, stands, power point, and other sound/music equipment.

Qualifications:

- Candidate must be at least 18 years old in order to be trained to operate some equipment.
- Candidate should have the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities that pertain to the position.
- Candidate must have and be able to communicate a relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Candidate must be able to honor the Camp Conquest Statement of Faith and Core Values.
- Ability to play instruments, especially guitar.

Physical Aspects of the Job:

- Candidate should be able to function in a natural, outdoor environment.
- Camp itself involves a lot of walking up and down hills.
